- A. The owner of each Condominium or other property will be entitled to one vote; and if one owner owns more than one dwelling unit or property, he or she will be entitled to one vote for each property owned.
- Q. What restrictions exist in the Association documents on my right to use my unit?
- A. Refer to Documents Second & Restated Declaration of Condominium of Turtle Creek East Article XII Use Restrictions and Exhibit H Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions of Turtle Creek East II.
- Q. How much are my assessments to the association for my unit type and when are they due?
- A. 54 Condominiums \$2,401; 33 Villas \$1,126. Assessments are collected quarterly April 1, July 1, September 1 and January 1.
- Q. Do I have to be a member in any other Association? If so, what is the name of the Association and what are my voting right in this Association? Also, how much are my assessments.
- A. Member of Turtle Creek Master Association. No vote. Included in Turtle Creek East quarterly assessment.
- Q. Am I required to pay rent or land use fees for recreational or other commonly used facilities? If so, how much am I obligated to pay annually?
- A. No
- Q. Is the Association or other mandatory membership Association involved in any such court cases in which it may face liability in excess of \$100,000? If so, identify each such case?
